Every Summer our AFIA committee arranges to take ten Leicestershire families away for a caravan holiday on the Lincolnshire Coast.

Transport to the caravan park is provided, and the families are supported for the duration of the holiday by the AFIA team. They arrange treats for the families during the week - offering care and support - whilst making it clear that their caravan door is always open!

The holiday is paid for by Mothers' Union members' donations and fund-raising events, and by grants from other local charities. In the past two years we have been very grateful to receive grants from the Poor's Platt charity in Barwell, whose support allowed some of their local families to enjoy an AFIA holiday, and Rudolph, Leicestershire Fire and Rescue charity.

Baby Basics

Baby Basics Leicester is a volunteer led project aiming to support the most vulnerable new mums and families, who are struggling to meet the financial and practical burden of looking after a new baby.

Families are referred to Baby Basics by **Social** workers, midwives and health visitors and vary from families who are struggling to afford the last few items they need for their baby, to families who need everything.

Our MU Leicester members support Baby Basics by donating toiletries, for both mums and babies, and hand knitted blankets. These blankets do have particular specifications that must be adhered to, so please ask before you knit!

Modern Day Slavery

In 2022 MU Members knitted 10,771 chain links, each one represented a possible MDS victim in our county. These chains were displayed in churches around the Diocese and at Leicester Cathedral to help raise awareness of Modern Day Slavery in Leicestershire.

MU Leicester is currently supporting Clewer's Make it Slavery Free initiative. Members have been asked to adopt one or more of these actions

Supporting families at HMP Leicester

In December 2022 we were contacted by the PACT (Prison Advice Care Trust) team at HMP Leicester, who asked if we could donate children's gifts, games and puzzles, to support a Christmas family day, allowing children to share some precious time with their father's.

PACT is a national charity that supports prisoners and their families by providing rehabilitation and sustaining family relationships during their period of incarceration. Children, especially, are the unseen victims of crime and suffer greatly when one of their parents is in prison.

The gifts that were donated by our members then provided the opportunity for each of the prisoners to give their child a Christmas present and, more recently, our members donated 104 Easter eggs to HMP Leicester and HMP Gartree.

There is great value in events such as these as they encourage good behaviour - only prisoners with the best behaviour records were eligible to attend the event - and research has shown that prisoners who keep in touch with their families during imprisonment are much less likely to re-offend in the future.

"We know supporting work around prisons isn't always a popular cause, so we are especially grateful for your support. It is really motivating to understand you share our concerns about the impact of imprisonment on children."
